You are now able to view your account, track your usage, and pay your bill from any computer 24-hours a day. Online payment with paperless billing is easy, secure and free. In addition to going paperless, you can set up automatic payments from your bank account or credit card.

There are several types of notifications you can receive by email such as bill notification, payment received, payment due soon, and payment due now.

Following are a few examples of when an email notification subscription could benefit you:

- Would you like a family member to be notified when your PUD bill has been issued or if your account ever becomes delinquent?
- Are you a snowbird who would like to be notified when your bill has been issued?
- Are you concerned about an elderly parent and would like to be notified if their account becomes delinquent?

Another feature of signing up for online access is the ability to view your usage history.
